In response to your request, we are pleased to provide the following Continuing Guaranty:

- 1) All resins used in the manufacture of Ropak containers meet the requirements of the CFIA and FDA Regulation 21 CFR 177.1520 (c) (3.1) and (3.2) Olefin Polymers and 21 CFR 178.2010 Anti-oxidants and/or Stabilizers for Polymers. These regulations describe copolymers that may be safely used as articles or components of articles used in packaging or holding food at low or room temperature. For holding food during cooking, the user should determine that the physical properties of the resin are compatible with the conditions of use.
- 2) The white color concentrate used in the manufacture of Ropak containers meet the requirements of the CFIA and FDA Regulations 21 CFR 175.300 and 178.3297. These regulations deal with resinous, polymeric coatings and colorants for polymers used in food contact applications. The white color and black color concentrate also meets the requirements of the CFIA and FDA regulations 21 CFR 177.1520, 178.2010 as described above and in the case of carbon black, 21 CFR 178.3297.
- 3) The gaskets and gasket compounds used in the manufacture of Ropak containers meet the requirements of the CFIA and FDA Regulations 21 CFR 177.1210 which deal with closures and sealing gaskets for food containers.
