SUBJECT: Material Data Safety Sheet (MSDS) for Hearing Protection Products

The Sperian Protection Company is the worldwide leader in personal protective equipment. The Sperian Hearing Protection Group markets the Howard Leight and Bilsom brands of hearing protection products.

The Occupational Safety and Health Administration (OSHA) discourages the creation of MSDS for **non-hazardous** materials. This practice can lead to confusion in the market place. MSDSs are only required for **hazardous** materials.

According to 29 CFR section 1910.1200 (c), hearing protection products are classified as articles and are exempt from Hazard Communications such as an MSDS as stated in section 1900.1200(b)(6)(v).

Our hearing protection products are non-hazardous materials and consequently no MSDS is required. However, on request we can provide a Certificates of Conformity and Physical Property Data Sheets for a particular hearing protection product that you purchase from The Sperian Protection Company.

The Sperian Hearing Protection Group is an ISO 9001 certified company that complies with applicable product testing and inspection requirements insuring conformity to written specifications and drawings. Our Quality records furnish objective evidence of activities performed or results achieved are maintained to demonstrate these quality requirements.
