



Alpet D2 Quat Test for Organic Processors:

The use of quat's can be permitted in organic processing plants as long as it has totally dissipated from the surface prior to applying food.

To test Alpet D2: Spray onto surface and allow to air dry. Apply a drop of water in 60 seconds increments to the area where Alpet D2 has evaporated. Using a test strip, rub the drop of water onto the strip (pHydrion QT-10 and QT-1000 papers are recommended or for lower concentrations the QL-110 Test Kit*). This will show if any quat remains.

In field tests, the quat was non-detectable 30 seconds after drying. This varies depending on humidity in your location.
