

Chlorine Test

Chlorine Test is a test paper for the semi-quantitative determination of chlorine in the range of 10-200 ppm.

Color reaction:

In the presence of chlorine the white test paper changes color to blue-violet.

Instructions for use:

Dip test strip **briefly** into the test solution and shake off excess off liquid. Compare reaction color **immediately** with color scale.

Remark:

If the test paper is discolored after dipping, the chlorine concentration is higher than 200 ppm. In this case the result should be ignored.

Storage:

Avoid exposing the test paper to sunlight and moisture. Store the container below +30°C in a dry place.
