The component materials used in Ammex gloves comply with the CFR 170-199 for all food contact. This includes meat and poultry. The powder (food grade corn starch) in powdered gloves also comply with the CFR 170-199 for all food contact.

Manufactured in FDA-inspected and ISO-9002 registered facilities.

The Role of the FDA & USDA in relation to gloves

The FDA regulates medical grade exam gloves. The FDA inspects facilities and randomly samples shipments. Our medical grade exam gloves meet or exceed FDA requirements.

Non-medical gloves, used in a variety of applications including food service, are generally manufactured in FDA inspected facilities also. The non-medical gloves should be marked "Not for Medical Use" so they are not used in medical situations where there is a chance for blood borne pathogen exposure.

The USDA regulates what glove material components are permissible for food contact. The USDA does not regulate gloves, and to our knowledge, at this time have any direct glove guidelines. Ammex disposable gloves comply with CFR 170-199 for food contact.

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
